All you have to do is read to your newborn, infant, or toddler (some parents are starting even before that!). The goal is to have read 1,000 books before your child starts kindergarten. Repeats are ok! It's the act of reading, not the story itself, that is important. Sounds impossible? Just read one book before bed each night and you will reach 1,095 in three years! Well before your little one goes off to school.
