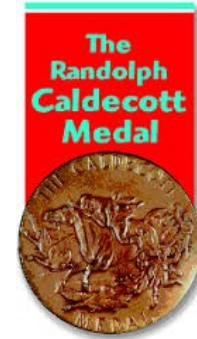


Caldecott Award Winners
